COMPETITIONS

Competitions may be entered on site until 2PM.

The following competitions will be entered:

Best breeding group

Best brace

Child and dog (age 3 – 6 years)

Child and dog II. (age 6 - 9 years)
Junior handling group 9 - 13 years
Junior handling group 13 - 18 years
Best head - male
Best head - female
Best ridge
Best gate - male
Best gate - female

Best stud dog – entry of at least 5 offsprings who have been judges on the day of the show. The type and the quality are assessed. The sire of the progeny group does not need to be present at the show nor does he need to be judged on the day of the show.

Only dogs that have been judged at the show can participate in the competitions (with the exception of the Child and Dog and Junior handling competitions).

CLASSES:

The division into classes is governed by the ČMKU exhibition regulations. The dog must reach the prescribed age for inclusion in the class on the day of the exhibition:

Baby class - 4 to 6 months
Puppy class - 6 to 9 months
Junior class - 9 to 18 months
Intermediate class - 15 to 24 months
Open class - from 15 months
Working class - from 15 months
Winner class - from 15 months
Honour class - from 15 months
Veteran class - from 8 years

For the entry into working class a Czech national working certificate needs to be presented.

The honour class is open to dogs with a recognized international or national champion title, National winner title, Club winner title, Specialty show winner title, European winner title, World winner title. The titles listed must be obtained in adult competition.

There is no obligation for the awarding of club show titles, grade and ranking are entered within the judging report. Winner of Excellent 1 from Honour class at club and specialty shows also takes place in the competition for the title BOB and BOS.

The Winner class is open to dogs with a recognized international or national champion title, National winner title, Club winner title, Specialty show winner title, European winner title, World winner title. The titles listed must be obtained in adult competition.

A copy of the titles obtained must be attached to the application within dog office.

Awarding of titles is not mandatory.

TITLES:

In each class, the order 1 - 4 is determined

CAJC, CAC, res. CAC

Best baby* – title may be awarded to male/female from baby class that have been awarded with VP1

Best puppy* – title may be awarded to male/female from puppy class that have been awarded with VP1

Best of Juniors, BOJ – title may be awarded to male/female from junior class that have been awarded with CAJC

Best of Veterans, BOV - title may be awarded to male/female from veteran class that have been awarded EXC1

Best of Honours* - title may be awarded to male/female from honour class that have been awarded EXC1

Club winner male and female (Saturday) – this title is contested by a male / female with EXC1, CAC from intermediate class, open class, working class and winner class

European Junior Club winner male and female (Sunday) – this title may be awarded to male and female in Junior class that has been awarded EXC1, CAJC

European Veteran Club winner male and female (Sunday) – this title may be awarded to male and female in Veteran class that has been awarded EXC1

European Club winner male and female (Sunday) – this title is contested by a male / female with EXC1, CAC from intermediate class, open class, working class and winner class

Best of Breed, BOB – this competition is entered by CAJC male + female, individuals with title European Club winner / /Club winner male + female, EXC1 male + female from Honour and Veteran class.

Best of Opposite Sex, BOS – this competition is entered by CAJC male/female, individuals with title European Club winner / /Club winner male/female, EXC1 male/female from Honour and Veteran class of the opposite sex to BOB winner.

The awarding of titles is not mandatory - the judge has the right to not award the title.

*The titles Best Baby, Best Puppy and Best of Honour class can be awarded at club shows, but according to the ČMKU Exhibition Rules, they cannot be entered in the Pedigree of the dogs.

VETERINARY CONDITIONS:

- dogs must be clinically healthy
- dogs no longer need proof of a clinical examination of their state of health
- Dogs coming from EU member states and third countries must be accompanied by a valid passport for small animals and must meet the conditions set by Regulation 998 of the European Parliament and the Council /2003 of 26/05/2003.

DOCUMENTS REQUIRED FOR PARTICIPATION IN THE EXHIBITION:

- proof of payment of the exhibition fee, copy of dog's pedigree, vaccination certificate or passport with valid vaccinations

GENERAL CONDITIONS:

A copy of the dog's pedigree, a copy of the proof of payment of the exhibition fee, working certificate (for the working class) and a copy of the championship for the winner class and honour class (international or national champion titles, National winner title, Club winner title, Specialty show winner title, European winner title, World winner title). Without a copy of the working certificate or championship certificate, the dog/bitch will be placed in the open class.

The organizer reserves the right not to accept an application without proof of payment of the exhibition fee.

A dog can only be registered in one class. Switching dogs after the 2nd deadline is not possible.

Show entry confirmation will not be sent out, a confirmation email from the dogoffice system will serve as confirmation of admission to the exhibition.

The organizer of the exhibition is not responsible for damages caused by the dog or the exhibitor in all areas of the venue, including accommodation areas. These are exclusively responsibility of the exhibitor. The organizer is not responsible for the death or loss of a dog. Dogs are not allowed to run free. Biting dogs must be muzzled. Non-participation in the exhibition for any reason cannot be a reason for claiming a refund of the exhibition fee.

The exhibitor agrees to the inclusion of his address in the catalogue.

The organizer reserves the right to change or add judges.

PROTESTS:

A protest against the referee's decision is not admissible. Protests can only be made for formal reasons of violating exhibition regulations. The protest must be submitted in writing, together with the deposit of CZK 2,000 during the show prior to end of judging. In case of the dismissal of the protest after evaluation, the deposit is forfeited in favour of the organizer of the exhibition.

The protest is decided by a two-member commission in accordance with the exhibition rules of the ČMKU.
